Statutes for Quality Enhancement Cell

The main purpose of QEC is to maintain and oversee quality education practices. Its objectives are:

- 1. To promote public confidence that the quality and standards of the award of degrees are enhanced and safeguarded.
- 2. To review quality standards and the quality of teaching and learning in each subject area.
- 3. To define clear and explicit standards as points of reference to the reviews to be carried out.
- 4. To develop qualifications framework by setting out the attributes and abilities that can be expected from the holder of a qualification, i.e. Bachelors, Bachelors with Honors, Master's, M Phil and Doctoral.
- 5. To develop program specifications in order to clarify what knowledge, understanding, skills and other attributes a student's needs to develop on successful completing a program.
- 6. To develop quality assurance processes and methods of evaluation to affirm that the quality of provision and the standard of awards are being maintained and to foster curriculum, subject and staff development, together with research and other activities.
- 7. To ensure that the university's quality assurance procedures are designed to fit in with the arrangements in

place nationally for maintaining and improving the quality of Higher Education.
