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
### WUM SDGs-Engagement Plan






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







#### Hardship Support & Grants

Poverty in Pakistan is higher in rural areas and lower in the cities. Out of total 40 million living below the poverty line, thirty million live in rural areas. More than 60 % students in WUM belong to rural areas of Southern Punjab. Since its inception in 2013, The Women University Multan has been offering financial assistance to its brilliant, needy, orphan and disabled students on the basis of need or student's financial status. Students Welfare Funds and Kinship Based Fee Concession granted to eligible students for their smooth educational activities without any interruption on monetary grounds based on their unaffordability.









In addition to above mentioned scholarships, university offers kinship as well as free of cost education todisabled students, siblings of martyers and students from deprived areas.





#### **Orientation Workshop for Ehsaas Scholarship**

Awareness Workshop on Ehsaas & Graduate Scholarship Program was organized on January 17, 2022, at WUM in which more than 400 students participated. Assistant Registrar Ms. Saira Nasir, while giving a briefing, said that Ehsaas Undergraduate Scholarship Program is the largest under graduate scholarship program in the history of Pakistan. Under this program, 50,000 students from low-income families are awarded scholarships each year to study in four to five-year undergraduate programs. She described in detail the procedure for the award of this scholarship. On the occasion, a large number of students were present.



Helping Other People Enthusiastically (HOPE), a society working under the patronage of Worthy Vice Chancellor, Prof. Dr. Uzma Quraishi, The Women University Multan, is a Student Organization launched at WUM to promote welfare activities in the society. HOPE is a home for enthusiastic young students who impart their role as positive contributors at times of social and national challenges. To help underprivileged section of society and daily wagers of the University during COVID-19, ration was distributed among Daily Wager as well as under privileged staff serving The Women University, Multan for which funds were collected by the HOPE Society from volunteers and staff members. This society is actively engaged in fund raising activities to contribute in well being of people in terms of food supply, helping needy students to pay their fee and to fulfill basic needs.

#### Seminar on Saudi Arabian Scholarship Program

Women University Multan hosted a seminar on Saudi Arabian scholarships to guide applicants on how to apply for scholarship in 25 Saudi Arabian universities. The seminar was held on July 5, 2022, at Katchery Campus. The seminar was organized by the Student Financial Aid Office, WUM. Students from 23 departments participated in the seminar. Addressing the seminar, Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Uzma Quraishi said that the announcement of Full Bright Scholarships by 25 Saudi Arabian Universities is a rare opportunity for Pakistani students to pursue their higher studies. Dr. Misbah Mirza (Focal Person, Scholarship Program) explained the process to apply for scholarship. Ms. Hashmi, Assistant Registrar, explained in detail the benefits of the scholarship (free accommodation, return air ticket, free medical, monthly allowance, etc.).







#### WUM's First Need-Based Scholarship Meeting

The first meeting of the Scholarship Management Committee (SMC) was held on June 3, 2022, at Katchery Campus, under the supervision of Dr. Misbah Mirza (Focal Person, SFAO). The meeting was attended by Mr. Rehan Qadir (Treasurer), Ms. Sunbal Hashmi (Representative Controller Examinations), Asad Ms. Igra Representative of Registrar), Mr. Rizwan (Representative of Resident Auditor). The agenda of the meeting was presented by Dr. Misbah Mirza for the first University Need-Based Scholarship for students of the University. Speaking on the occasion, Dr. Misbah Mirza said that the scholarship aims to provide financial assistance to students so that they can continue their educational activities without any hindrance.













#### **Reducing Food Wastage**

Pakistan is an agrarian economy where agriculture is the second largest sector. Though food production is sufficient to feed all the population in the state, still there is a food insecurity. The World Food Programme states that 43 percent of the country's population remains food insecure, and out of that, 18 percent of people are facing an alarming dearth of food. Wastage of food is one of the major reasons of hunger in our country. According to an estimation, almost 40 percent of food is wasted in Pakistan. On one side, people are dying due to hunger, and on the other, there is an abundance of food that goes to waste.

WUM aims to address the challenge by minimizing food wastage to achieve food security. Sustainable practices include buffet system for students in hostel so students and employees take as per their requirement. Leftover food is distributed among staff

Researchers at department of Biochemistry and Biotechnology are engaged in developing environment friendly fertilizers to increase mass production of wheat and rice.







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#### Establishment of Flood Relief Assistance Centre

WUM has launched Flood Relief Assistance Centre for fund-raising and to help flood victims in Pakistan. For assistance of flood victims, an aid package has been prepared by WUM including teachers, students, employees and staff consisting of cash, food items, life-saving medicines, baby milk, hygiene items, clothes, sanitary, clean drinking water and kitchen utensils to benefit more affected people of South Punjab region. Focal person Dr. Mamoona Khan said that Pakistan is going through the worst natural disaster of decades, where floodwater has covered one-third of the Pakistani lands and affected more than 33 million people. Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Uzma Quraishi said that WUM Flood Relief Assistance Centre will help in mobilizing stakeholders and the general public to donate more funds for the noble cause. "And whoever saves a life, it will be as if they saved all of humanity" (Holy Quran)



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Fund– Raising Campaign for Flood Victims

Meeting with Heads of Departments for Fund Raising Campaign The Women University Multan requested its students, faculty and staff as well as general public to contribute in the Flood Relief Fund established to support the flood affected people. WUM community donated items especially for winters (e.g. clothing, shawls, blankets etc) and dry food items (flour, rice, ghee, pulses, sugar, tea, milk etc) at Relief Camp established at Katchery Campus, WUM.

To supervise the flood relief campaign, an important meeting was chaired by Registrar Dr. Qammar Rubab, in which the chairpersons of all departments participated, the plight of the flood victims was discussed in the meeting and it was decided that according to the vision of Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Quraishi, such a process should be prepared in which the victims will be provided with the basic necessities of life. Addressing the meeting, Registrar Dr. Qammar Rubab appealed to citizens to donate generously to WUM relief camp so that the needy can be helped.





 Under Flood Relief Assistance Centre WUM, all departments of the university nominated their focal person along with students for collection of relief good items for flood victims of Rajanpur District. These items included winter clothing, dry eatables items, medicines, tents, sanitary, cooking utensils. Focal person of FRAC WUM Dr. Mamoona Khan said that the citizens of Rajanpur will not be left alone, more aid programs will be conducted by the Women University to collect as much money and goods as possible.

• The teachers and students of Department of Chemistry, WUM, prepared mosquito repellent lotion for the flood victims. The faculty of Chemistry Department prepared mosquito repellent lotion for the people trapped in the flood, for which the raw material was also purchased by the teachers themselves. In this regard, the coordinator of the relief camp Dr. Mamoona Khan said that according to the instructions of the vice chancellor, we are taking effective measures for the flood victims. In this regard Chemistry department has prepared 200 bottles of mosquito repellent lotion. Vice- Chancellor Dr. Uzma Quraishi said that faculty and employees are doing commendable efforts for this campaign.

- Rajanpur. His team briefly explained the damages caused by flood. He appreciated the efforts of Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Quraishi and WUM team. He said that it is commendable initiative taken by VC Women University Multan to see women leadership at forefront of relief efforts. VC Prof. Dr. Quraishi said that the Punjab government's timely measures to address the situation were commendable. She assured to provide collaborative assistance at every platform for educational, mental well-being and social development of flood victims. Later on, the team of WUM donated relief goods, food and other items for the flood victims.
- WUM Flood Relief Assistance Centre Joins Hands with Pak Army for Flood Relief Donation & Medical Camp
- The Pakistan Army has established 212 relief collection points to support flood affected people in different cities of Pakistan. In this regard, the team of Flood Assistance Relief Centre, WUM, visited army relief camp for donating food, medicine drinking water, sanitary and other items to the flood-hit masses. A medical team conducted clinical examination of rain affected people. The team interacted with Major Matiullah who said that this climate change nightmare has made millions homeless and thousands have lost their lives.





## Mushroom Cultivation Project

A project titled "Mushroom Cultivation by Lignocellulosic Waste" was completed by the students of BS Botany (session 2018-2022 & 2019-2023) under the supervision of Ms. Uzma Ishaq. Students of Department of Botany grew Agaricus bisporus on self-made compost containing wheat straw and animal manure as primary substrate via tray cultivation on small scale. The project took 3-4 months to complete and fresh edible mushrooms were harvested. This short project will pave way for the commercialization of mushrooms in long term planning of Departmental revenue generation strategies.









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To celebrate World Antimicrobial Awareness Week, International Symposium on Recent Trends in Antimicrobial Resistance was organized by the Department of Microbiology and Molecular Genetics on November 22, 2022, at Mattital Campus. Participants from different universities joined online. Competition of poster presentations was also held and certificates were given to position holders.







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#### Seminar on Antimicrobial Resistance

Department of Chemistry organized a seminar on "Antimicrobial Resistance" at Jinnah Hall Katchery Campus. This event's Patron in chief was Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr Uzma Quraishi and invited speaker was Dr. Muhammad Wajid Khurshid Sipra (Associate Professor, MBBS, MPhil, Microbiology, Quaid-e-Azam Medical College, Bahawalpur) and seminar host was Dr. Tanzeela Rehman (Lecturer, Department of Chemistry).



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The Women University Multan signed a memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Association for Bio-risk Management (ABM). Prof. Dr. Uzma Qureshi, Vice Chancellor, WUM, Dr. Javed Khan, Program Director Health Security Partners, Dr. Asghar Ali, Executive Director ABM, Dr. Mujahid Khan, Team Leader ABM, Dr. Qamar Rubab, Registrar and Dr. Atia MMG Department, WUM, attended the MOU signing ceremony. It mainly entails an agreement to initiate activities on the protection of the research experimental setups and sustainability of the biomedical labs. Additionally, with direct relevance to the WUM's drive of adapting UNdefined SDGs, this MoU imparts a special emphasis on the reduction of the environmental hazards being produced through labs in the form of residue and waste materials.





#### **Construction of Sports Complex**

The Women University Multan gives great importance to mental and physical health of its students and faculty. This commitment is best demonstrated in the establishment of University Sports complex at Mattital campus (new campus) and up gradation of sports facilities at Katchery campus (old campus). Sports ground in Katchery campus was rehabilitated into a Multi-Purpose Sports Facility where Construction/Rehabilitation Program includes: Futsal Ground, Basketball Court, Table Tennis Area, Tracks and Paving Areas, Seating Arrangement, Ball Stop Net and Electrical Works. The project was sponsored bv DAI (Development Alternatives Incorporated).





#### **Awareness Seminar on Prevention of Thalassemia & Screening Camp**

An awareness seminar and screening camp was organized at WUM by Department of Biochemistry and Biotechnology on June 21, 2022, in collaboration with Govt. Of Punjab Thalassemia Prevention Program at Katchery Campus. The special guests of the seminar were CEO Health Multan, Syed Muhammad Ali Mehdi and Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Uzma Quraishi. The focal person of the seminar was Dr. Maryam Zain (Chairperson, Department of Biochemistry & Biotechnology) while the organizing committee included Dr. Raheela, Dr. Farah Deeba, Dr. Tahira, Dr. Saba, Dr. Aqsa and Dr. Raheela Waheed. Addressing the seminar, Syed Muhammad Ali Mehdi said that children suffering from thalassemia are a collective responsibility of our society. Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Uzma Quraishi said that the most effective way to prevent thalassemia is to engage all sections of the society including media, scholars, politicians, NGOs and people involved in education and health. Addressing the seminar Dr. Maryam Zain (Chairperson, Biochemistry & Biotechnology Department) and Mr. Ahmed Nadeem gave a brief introduction on genetic diseases. Dr. Aslam Sheikh explained the symptoms, signs and treatment of thalassemia. Dr. Shahida Parveen highlighted the importance of CVS testing. Dr. Mariam Khan spoke about the PTGD progress. The seminar was attended by Chairpersons and students of all departments. At the end, certificates were distributed among the participants.










#### **3-D Projects on Lab Designing**

Department of Applied Psychology and the Counseling and Well-Being Centre, WUM, organized a seminar to raise awareness, reduce social stigma, increase help-seeking for suicidal thoughts, highlight the need for mental health, and Islamic religious coping to address self-harm and suicide through preventive actions. The seminar was conducted by Ms. Rabia Nayab (Psychologist at Police Training College, Multan), Ms. Moneeza Butt (Clinical Psychologist at Violence Against Women Centre and Mind Care Centre), and Dr. Kalsoom Paracha (Chairperson/Associate Professor, Department of Islamic Studies & Comparative Religions). Dr. Sadia Musharraf (Teacher Incharge, Department of Applied Psychology) was the focal person to organize this seminar.



#### **Awareness Seminar on Breast Cancer**

Breast Cancer Awareness Seminar was organized by Department of Zoology, WUM, in collaboration with MINAR Cancer Hospital Multan. •An International Symposium on Mental Health Awareness was organized by Department of Zoology, WUM, on 23 December, 2022, at Mattital Campus in which teachers and students of the Department of Zoology and other Departments from Faculty of Life Sciences actively participated. #### **World Alzheimer Day**

World Alzheimer Day was observed at WUM on 21 September, 2022, to raise awareness about Alzheimer disease, a progressive neurologic disorder that is the most common cause of dementia. It slowly destroys memory, thinking, behavior, social skills, language, and eventually, the ability to carry out the simplest tasks. Alzheimer disease is most common in people over the age of 65. According to World Health Organization, Alzheimer & Dementia Deaths in Pakistan reached 15,216 or 1.04% of total deaths. Considering this, an awareness-raising session was conducted by Dr. Sadia Musharraf (Teacher In-Charge, Department of Applied Psychology) to identify the signs and symptoms of Alzheimer's disease, highlight the need to provide support to loved ones living with Alzheimer, and strategies to address the stigma and psychosocial issues associated with dementia. The awareness session was followed by a walk. Students and faculty join the walk dawning purple attire, holding colored flowers, posters, and balloons representative of their connection to Alzheimer disease as a caregiver of someone or supporting the cause. The program was jointly organized by the Department of Applied Psychology and Counseling and Well-Being Centre, WUM. Dr. Sadia Musharraf was the focal person to organize this event.









#### Fatimid Foundation Blood Donation Camp for Thalassemia Patients

Women University Multan organized a blood donation camp for thalassemia children under the auspices of Director Student Affairs, WUM, and Fatimid Foundation on September 29, 2022, at WUM in which faculty members and students donated their blood for thalassemia patients. Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Quraishi said that saving someone's life by donating blood is a priceless gift to humanity. She appreciated students and faculty for donating blood. Later, a blood camp was organized in which teachers and students donated blood.

## **EDUCATION FOR ALL**

#### 6,000+ Students

The Women University Multan was originally the Katchery Campus of Government Degree College for Women. It became the Women University in 2012 under the 2010 Act approved by the Punjab Assembly. The university has six faculties offering both undergraduate and postgraduate courses. Students can choose to study arts and social sciences, life science, science, religion and languages, or economics, commerce and management sciences. Within each faculty there are several departments specializing in particular areas. There are two campuses at the university, Katchery and Mattital. The Katchery campus is where the university began as a College, however the space was deemed insufficient for university activities. This led to the construction of the Mattital campus, which is fully equipped with a central library, a medical Centre, and student accommodation.





## Labs and Research Facilities

To provide first hand learning experience to the students of WUM and to produce outstanding stuff of future female scientists and professionals, university has established modern Labs in its different departments. There are 5 general and 5 research laboratories in departments of Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Physics and MMG. There are 5 computer labs in departments of Computer Sciences and Information Technology, English, Statistics and Mathematics. Continuous up gradation is undergoing in these labs with numerous new and advance research equipments to provide students facilitation in their studies.








# **Professional Development Program**


### World Water Day

#### Water Purification by Membrane Technology

Importance of water resources is universally recognized but increasing water pollution has seriously ruined water quality. Treating water at lowest possible level is especially desirable in developing countries, both in terms of cost and simpler operating units.

Women researchers at WUM are working to develop a low cost, efficient membrane system involving advanced mechanisms like mechanisms like selective permeability for salts due to membrane structure, antimicrobial potential for microbes due to organic compounds and photo catalytic degradation of other contaminants due to photoactive materials.

# WUM becomes first women's university to adopt solar energy

MULTAN: Pakistan is in a groundbreaking move towards energy conservation and costeffective practices. The Women University Multan (WUM) has become the first women's university in Pakistan to adopt solar energy. Under the visionary leadership of Vice Chancellor Prof Dr Uzma Quraishi, the university recently inaugurated a state of the art Solar Panel Project at its Katchery campus

This pioneering initiative was made possible through the support

and collaboration of the Energy Department of Punjab Government and the Punjab Energy Efficiency and Conservation Agency (PECA). The solarization process, successfully completed at both the Matital and Katchery campuses, involved the installation of a 400 KW grid. As a result, the university is now projected to generate approximately 1600 units of electricity on a daily basis. At the inauguration ceremony, Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Uzma Ouraishi expressed her delight at the university's transition to solar power. She emphasized the significant benefits this move would bring, both in terms of cost savings and environmental impact. WUM is expected to



save millions of rupees in electricity expenses. Additionally, the surplus electricity generated will contribute to the local power grid, ensuring the availability of clean energy for the region. The event saw the attendance of several distinguished guests, including Project Director Asad Ali Bhutta and Mr. Nadeem, the managing head of Ghulam Rasool Company, who provided insights into the solar panel project. Notable figures such as Registrar Dr. Qammar Rubab, Additional Registrar Dr. Saadia Irshad, Treasurer Mr. Rehan Qadir, and chairpersons of various departments were also present, along with enthusiastic students -Staff Reporter









Congratulations the Women University Multan for moving towards solar energy. The first Women University in Pakistan to take a practice step towards saving energy and securing millions of funds to using university enhancement.

Solarization process completed with the support of Energy Department, Punjab Government and Punjab Energy Efficiency and Conservation Agency (PECA) at the Women University Multan. In this regard, 400 KW grid has been installed in both campuses. Two grids are installed at Matital Campus and Katchery Campus, from which the University will generate around 1600 units on daily basis. Vice Chancellor Prof Dr Uzma Quraishi inaugurated the solar panel system at Katchery campus. On this occasion, Project director Asad Ali Bhutta and managing head of Ghulam Rasool Company Mr. Nadeem briefed the participants about the project .Addressing the ceremony VC Prof. Dr Uzma Quraishi said that this is a very good sign that the university is gradually converting its power load to a solar system. The university will save millions of rupees in terms of electricity and additional electricity will also be available while green energy will also have a positive impact on the environment, the university is progressing rapidly and its infrastructure will be improved further. 




















#### **Job Placement Center**
























#### World Environment Day

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# **Role of WUM During Flood Campaign 2022**



#### Meeting of Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Quraishi with Additional Chief Secretary, Southern Punjab

The Women University became active for the restoration of schools in the flood-affected areas. In this regard, WUM has offered assistance to the Southern Punjab Secretariat in establishing camp schools in flood-affected areas.

This presentation was made by Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Uzma Qureshi during a meeting with Additional Chief Secretary Southern Punjab Captain R. Saqib Zafar. Additional Chief Secretary Southern Punjab welcomed the presentation of the Vice Chancellor. Prof. Dr. Uzma Qureshi said that Women University will also examine the problems of women in flood-affected areas, and a report based on suggestions for solving these problems will be submitted to the government.

#### Establishment of Flood Relief Assistance Centre

WUM has launched Flood Relief Assistance Centre for fund-raising and to help floodvictims in Pakistan. For assistance of flood victims, an aid package has been prepared by WUM including teachers, students, employees and staff consisting of cash, food items, life-saving medicines, baby milk, hygiene items, clothes, sanitary, clean drinking water and kitchen utensils to benefit more affected people of South Punjab region. Focal person Dr. Mamoona Khan said that Pakistan is going through the worst natural disaster of decades, where floodwater has covered one-third of the Pakistani lands and affected more than 33 million people. Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Uzma Ouraishi said that WUM Flood Relief Assistance Centre will help in mobilizing stakeholders and the general public to donate more funds for the notific cause. #### Fund–Raising Campaign for Flood Victims

The Women University Multan requested its students, faculty and staff as well as general public to contribute in the Flood Relief Fund established to support the flood affected people. WUM community donated items especially for winters (e.g. clothing, shawls, blankets etc) and dry food items (flour, rice, ghee, pulses, sugar, tea, milk etc) at Relief Camp established at Katchery Campus, WUM.
